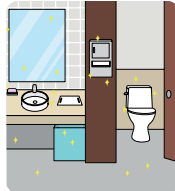

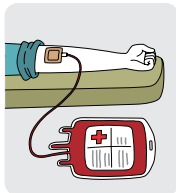

Meaning of Civil Air Defense Warning

Please remember the meaning of the civil air defense warning and listen carefully.




an alert alarm	<p>When an enemy attack is expected</p>  <p>Voice Broadcasting </p> <p>Civil defense text broadcasting </p>
an air raid warning	<p>When an attack is imminent or under attack</p>  <p>Siren </p> <p>Voice Broadcasting </p> <p>Civil defense text broadcasting </p>
a fire alarm	<p>When there is or is expected to be an enemy fire and defense attack</p>  <p>Voice Broadcasting </p> <p>Civil defense text broadcasting </p>
a nuclear alert	<p>When there's a nuclear explosion or it's expected</p>  <p>Siren </p> <p>Voice Broadcasting </p> <p>Civil defense text broadcasting </p>
경보 해제	<p>Immediately after the attack and when no further attack is expected</p>  <p>Voice Broadcasting </p> <p>Civil defense text broadcasting </p>

National Civil Defense Drill



A drill for an air raid warning
Evacuation of residents + Fire truck ambulance road marking

August 20, 2 PM, 20 minutes

-  **2:00 PM**, When the training air raid warning is issued, **evacuate quickly**.
-  If you see a **fire truck** or **ambulance** while driving, **make sure to yield**.
-  **2:15 PM**, You can move from the **shelter** when the alert is issued

2:20 PM: Alert lifting!
Return to your usual activities.

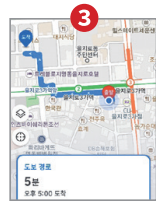
How to search for shelters



Search for a Shelter.

Packing a Go Bag

Bottled water, snacks, flashlight, first aid supplies, radio (batteries), toilet paper (wet tissue), raincoat, blanket, gas mask, rubber gloves, boots, plastic bag, etc



Once the air raid warning is issued, Evacuate safely

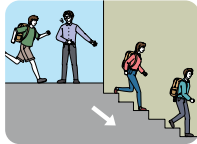
When the **alert** is issued



Listening to the radio



Prepare to carry personal protective equipment



Suspension of business and preparation for evacuation (or evacuation)

If the **air raid warning** is issued



Evacuate immediately to a civil defense shelter or nearby underground facility



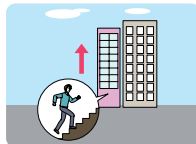
While driving Stop on the right side of the road, evacuate, and listen to the radio.



Vacant lot nearby Take the fire escape instead of the elevator.

If the **fire safety alert** is issued

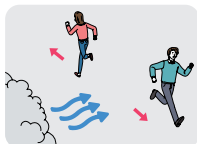
Evacuation Procedures in Case of a Chemical Weapons Attack



High indoor location that can block outside air



If the wind blows toward the contaminated area, evacuate in the opposite direction of the wind.



If the wind blows toward me from a contaminated area, take shelter in a direction perpendicular to the direction the wind is blowing.

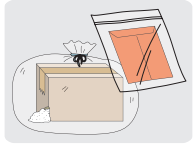
How to respond to biological weapons attacks



Protect the nose and mouth and evacuate or return to the designated place



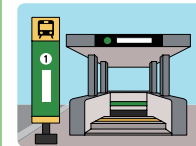
Keep clean and cook for more than 15 minutes



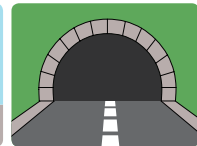
Any suspicious mail is reported to the health center

If a **nuclear alert** is issued

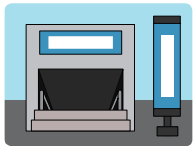
When the alarm goes off - evacuate immediately to the underground facility

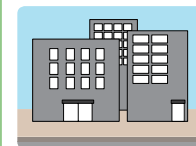

If a nuclear bomb goes off - get down quickly



Regardless of the direction of the nuclear explosion, use the surrounding terrain to lie prone. Cover your eyes and ears, open your mouth, and avoid touching your stomach.

After nuclear detonation - radiation and fallout avoidance

Use a raincoat and umbrella when moving
